‘Yes but, No but, Yes but’ - House of Commons'

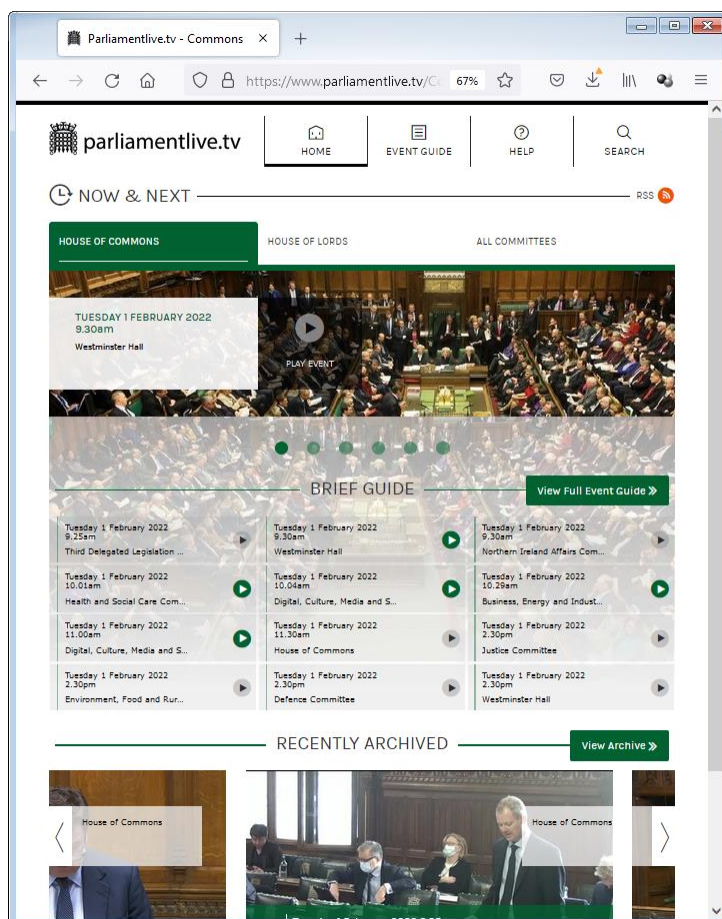
Preliminary directions are as follows:

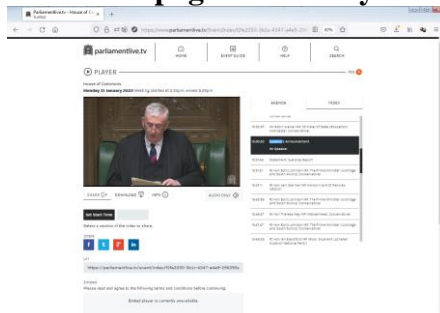
